Jennifer's PARTY PLANNING TIPS

- Don't wait until the last minute.
 Buy beverages the week before, assemble balloon garlands a few days in advance, and polish the Champagne flutes well before the party gets started.
- Know when to delegate. Just because you can scour the Internet for the perfect paper straws doesn't mean you should. Let someone do the shopping for you. With a few clicks of a button, you can have a party in a box delivered straight to your door.
- Don't stock a full bar. Serve beer, wine or Champagne, and a specialty cocktail you can make in advance. My favorite New Year's Eve drink is a simple Champagne punch finished off with a rock candy swizzle stick.
- Be consistent. Whether it's a color scheme or a general theme, stick to it. Disco balls and flamingoes are both great party additions, but they're not the best combo.
- Don't forget about yourself. The day of the party, get yourself ready before putting the finishing touches on your event. Your guests won't notice a missing garnish, but they will notice how frazzled you are if you haven't taken some time for yourself.
